

At close, the Sensex was down 1,390.41 points or 1.80 percent at 76,024.51, and the Nifty was down 353.65 points or 1.50 percent at 23,165.70.

At the close of the NYSE, the Dow Jones Industrial Average lost 1.69%, closing at 41,584, while the S&P 500 index lost by 1.97%, closing at 5,581 and the NASDAQ Composite index fell 2.70%, ending at 17,323.

On the Multi-Commodity Exchange (MCX) gold futures contracts rose by Rs 677 to their new all-time high of Rs 90,797. Silver futures contracts opened higher at Rs 1,00,791/kg, gaining of Rs 726 or 0.73%.

U.S. West Texas Intermediate crude declined 27 cents, or 0.4%, to \$69.09 a barrel. Brent crude futures fell 21 cents, or 0.3%, to \$72.55 a barrel.

The rupee ended at 85.5720 against the U.S. dollar, compared to 85.4200 in the previous session.
